Brother Knights, you may have heard it said before- God works in mysterious ways. Before leaving our last monthly meeting Steve Hart asked me if I could get the kids who attended Camp Joshua to write about their experiences at the camp. Well, God used Steve to set in motion from this little act a chain of events where we were able to raise funds to send all six to the week long summer camp. How? Well, from what the kids collectively wrote down was so impressive that Jackie Russell got the KC Auxiliary to donate \$200. And the Carmelites a few days later funded over \$800. This was truly amazing.... and now I will share with you the words from the kids themselves.

Quote "Before we went to Camp Joshua, we had little knowledge why exactly we were pro-life, but now we know why we hold those beliefs how to spread the word. The camp taught us some very important details of fetal development and the devastating effects abortion has on women physically and emotionally. Even further, we learned how to spread the word with practical and realistic pro-life ideas and events, such as baby showers, a cemetery of the innocents, and many others. We have already completed our first project (with the help of some money from the KC council at our church) where we filled pink and blue Easter eggs with jelly beans and some delightful pro-life sayings (such as "Did you know your heart was beating when you were the size of these jelly beans?"). We gave them out after mass on Easter and brought them to all the CCD classes the following week, and we've seen a very positive impact on the children. This project essentially put a pro-life message in

600 homes in our community. We plan on continuing events at our church.

Not only did we learn how to spread the word with these types of big events, but we learned how to defend our beliefs in the daily discussions we have with our peers. We learned methods of defending our beliefs and debating strategies. We were also introduced to some of the main pro-choice arguments and specifically taught us how to prove them logically and morally false.

The friendships all of us were able to establish at Camp Joshua have been wonderful. As pro-life teenagers, we often feel like the minority at school, and it was great to meet other young people who share our beliefs. We have a Facebook page and continue to talk, share articles and current events, and support one another. Together, we have brought about some good debates on the Planned Parenthood Facebook page, and whenever someone needs help with a response to a pro-choice argument, we help one another. The knowledge and the friends we gained through Camp Joshua give us the confidence to stand up for life in our community." End of Quote




