The Campaign For People With Intellectual Disabilities will run from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. The Knights of Columbus Supreme Council has taken over production and supply of new CPID vests. These vests will be available for purchase starting February/ early March 2020 on Supplies Online, the supply portal for Council Officers (available via Officers Online) The price can vary, please remember when ordering shipping is extra.

Brandon and I made it easier to submit the Financial Report Statement online through the State Website, councils can fill it out and hit submit, and the report will come to me. I do hope that your council will like this better than mailing. For councils without computer access please email me, and I will send you a Financial Report Statement, fill it out, and mail it back to me. I am always interested in seeing where their hard work and monies goes to, and in turn I can help mentioning to other councils where they may be able to send their funds to in their area. Worthy's you will fill out the administrative report stating you did the C.P.I.D. Program.
