### **2023-2024 Essay Topic**

**How can the Church evangelize in the digital age?** Pope St. Paul VI wrote: “The task of evangelizing all people constitutes the essential mission of the Church.”

### **Rules and Regulations**

- The Knights of Columbus Essay Contest is open to all Catholic Students from public, private, or parochial schools in grades 8-12.
- Each essay must reflect the assigned theme and be the student’s original work.
- Each Essay must be typed and contain between 500-750 words.
- All Council submissions must have the Supreme Essay Participation Form attached and include the signature of the student and parent.
- One winning essay from each grade level will advance to the next level of competition.
- The student’s name should only appear on the official entry form and not in the essay.

### **Deadlines**

- September 1, 2023- Deadline to Order Essay Kits from the Supreme Council
- November 5, 2023- Deadline for Students to submit essays to their Councils
- December 5, 2023- Deadline for Councils to submit its winning essays to the Diocesan Administrators
- January 2, 2024- Deadline for Diocesan Administrators to State Community Director

### **Judging**

Essay will be judged on a 100-point scoring system.

- 35 Points Content- How clearly is the theme presented?
- 30 Points Grammar- Does the essay reflect proper sentence and paragraph and utilize correct spelling?
- 35 Points Style- Does the essay show creativity, imagination, and development of the topic in a compelling style?

## **Awards**

- Councils are encouraged to create their own awards.
- Diocesan winners in each grade level will receive a \$50.00 check.
- State winners in each grade level will receive a \$200.00 check.
- State winners will advance to the Knights of Columbus International Essay Contest.
- International winners in each grade level will receive \$300 and a framed certificate
- The Supreme Council will honor two essay runners-up in each grade level and each runner-up will receive \$100 and a framed certificate.
