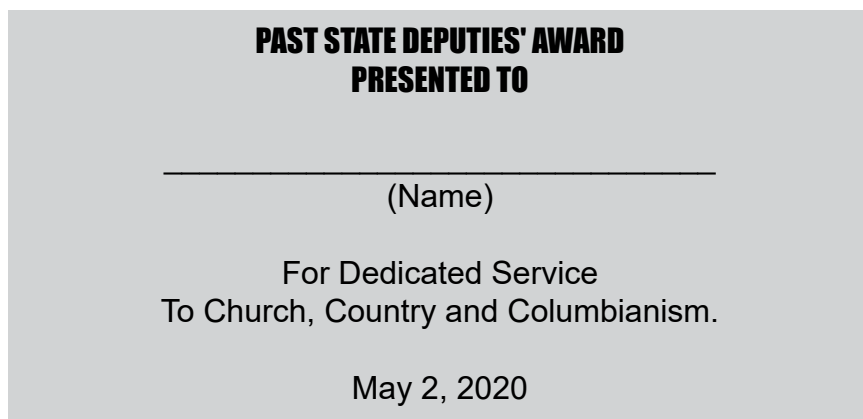

PAST STATE DEPUTIES' ANNUAL AWARD
