INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING ENTRY FORM

1. Complete all information as requested on the form. Entrants may be contacted by email or called long distance COLLECT if information is not completed correctly or supplied.

2. Signature of your Financial Secretary is NOT required. To verify your status as a Knight of Columbus in good standing, you must present a valid and current Membership Card with your membership number clearly displayed, at the time of registration. Your dues must be paid through March 31st of the current year to be in good standing for this tournament.

3. Entry Fee of \$175.00 includes Green Fee and cart rental for the Thursday and Friday rounds of golf and the socials on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday night.

4. Scramble Fee of \$ 50.00 includes Green Fee and cart rental for Wednesday's event.

5. Ladies Scramble Fee of \$ 50.00 includes Green Fee and cart rental for Thursday's event.

6. Scotch Doubles Fee of \$ 100.00 per Team, includes Green Fee and cart rental for Tuesday's event.

7. Wives, adult guest, children 13 and over and non-golfers may attend Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday Socials for a fee of \$ 80.00 per person.

8. Fee for children 12 & under is \$ 40.00 and includes Wednesday, Thursday and Friday Socials.

9. Ladies Luncheon Fee on Friday has a separate cost of \$25.00.

10. TRANSPORTATION FEE OF \$10.00 PER PERSON IS FOR TRAVEL FROM THE HOLIDAY INN LAFAYETE TO AND FROM GOLF COURSES ONLY.

11. PRE-FLIGHT SCORE INFORMATION: If you checked the entry blank as a first-time entrant, you must provide one of the following:

a) Photocopy of your home club handicap card within one month of Tournament Entry Deadline.

b) Two (2) 18-hole rounds must be played within a month of the Entry Deadline and the scorecards must be signed by the course professional or the assistant professional and submitted to the host council by the Deadline.

TOUR INFORMATION

Tuesday June 14th - Historic Tour

This tour leaves the Holiday Inn Lafayette at 8:30 am. You will travel to St. Martinville, Louisiana and visit historic St. Martin de Tours Catholic Church, the mother church of the Acadians established in 1765. You will hear the tale of Evangeline and Gabriel, the inspiration of the poet Longfellow and the tears of Evangeline under the old live oak tree.

From there you will visit Shadows on the Teche plantation home located in New Iberia, Louisiana. This lovely mansion, built in 1834 was the home of David Weeks. It is said to be the most photographed mansion in the South. The Shadows is on the National Trust for Preservation list. Authentic and original furnishings are still present in the mansion.

At this point, lunch will be provided.

After lunch you will travel to the Jungle Gardens on Avery Island. You will see thousands of plants from around the world. There is also 64 varieties of bamboo planted (one for each Louisiana parish). You will visit the wonderful bird sanctuary where snowy egrets and blue herons return each year to make nests and raise their young. This will be a driving tour from the bus.

Finally, you will be taken to the world famous Tabasco Factory. An informed guide will walk you through the gallery explaining artifacts and the growing technique. You will then see a film with beautiful shots of the island and the men and women working – still picking the peppers by hand. You will also have the opportunity to visit the country store and receive a small souvenir.

Wednesday June 15th – Cajun Heritage Tour

This tour leaves the Holiday Inn Lafayette at 8:30 am. You will take a short ride in Lafayette to Vermilionville. This is an authentic Cajun/Creole heritage town, replica from 1765 to 1890. This is how Acadiana looked 200 years ago. The town sits on the Vermilion Bayou and is truly a walk back in time. You will stroll the grounds, visit the old church and enjoy the artifacts. You will see costumed craftsman making quilts, cooking, working in the boat shed and building wares.

Next you will visit the Jean Lafitte Center located next to Vermilionville. The center is staffed by the National Park Service. We are proud of our heritage and you will learn the way of the Acadiana people. A film presentation will explain how the Acadians were banished from Nova Scotia and families were separated. Everything from oil and gas to farming is explored in this attraction.

At this point, lunch will be provided.

Finally, you will be taken to the picturesque Atchafalaya Basin Swamp for a boat tour. You will see the beauty and glory of this area. You will journey through the cypress jungles where our ancestors worked, lived and played centuries ago. You will see native wildlife, which will include alligators.
