2018-2019 State Deputy's Award

Councils conducting well-rounded programs in the Faith in Action program categories of Faith, Family, Community, and Life provide meaningful help to people and families. Through our programs, members will be able to work together to accomplish much more than they could acting alone, and they'll also build bonds of friendship and fraternity which will last a lifetime. By conducting well-run service programs, your council continues the vision of our founder by assisting people in need, strengthening our faith, and strengthening the bonds that unite our members.

Councils that conduct well-rounded service programs may be eligible for the State Deputy's Award and the Fleur de Lis Award that recognize the efforts that councils put forth in continuing Father McGivney's mission.

Reporting Period: April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019.

The activity reporting period for this fraternal year is from April 1st to March 31st. Only activities conducted during this time period are to be reported.

Deadline to submit Activity Reports (Grading Forms): April 5, 2019.

Activity Reports (Grading Forms) must be IN THE HANDS of the respective director NO LATER THAN APRIL 5th of the reporting year. Postmarks will not be used to determine if the report is received on time. There will be no exceptions to this deadline, and reports received after the deadline will not be graded. Online grading forms are de-activated at 11:59 p.m. on April 5, 2019

Method to Determine Winners of the 2018-2019 State Deputy's Award

Councils will compete in one of three groups based upon the councils' size as of July 1, 2018.

Group 1	110 or more regular members.
Group 2	60 to 109 regular members.
Group 3	59 or less regular members.

"Regular members" includes all members listed on the council's roster as of July 1, 2018, except Inactive Members, Honorary Members, Honorary Life Members, and Disabled Members.

The highest cumulative score determines the ranking.

Method to Determine Fleur De Lis Award Winners

All councils will also be recognized with a “FLEUR DE LIS” award if they score a minimum of 80% in each of the six categories (for example: at least 160 out of 200 points and 80 out of 100 points).

6 Categories	1,000 points (plus 50 bonus points can be earned)
Faith	200 points
Family	200 points
Community	200 points
Life	200 points (plus 20 bonus points)
YEP ¹	100 points (based on percent of quota received by April 5)
Admin/State Events ²	100 points (plus 30 additional bonus points)

Tiebreaker: The tiebreaker for the State Deputy’s Award is determined by the Service Program Awards Entry Form (STSP). The Elected State Officers and the Immediate Past State Deputy evaluate and rate the Service Program Awards Entry Form submitted by the councils. Points for each form submitted in the various categories are:

1st Place: 5 points	4th Place: 2 points
2nd Place: 4 points	5th Place: 1 point
3rd Place: 3 points
