Knights of Columbus Leadership Seminar - July 21, 2018 State Website

Brother Knights,

The state website is a resource that helps get information to many people, both members and non-members. This includes information about our state officers, chairmen, and directors, our programs, and schedules of events include our degree exemplifications, and our councils. For this information to be accurate, it must be provided by our members to the State Webmaster.

Programs: Information regarding our programs, including schedules, forms, and presentations, is posted, so that we can promote our programs and get as many councils and people to participate as possible. Some programs, such as the Catholic Youth Leadership Award, are also targeted to non-members. Many programs, besides promoting Faith, Family, Community, and Life, also target non-member into becoming members. Councils should use this information to Plan, Promote, and Participate in state programs as well as using the information on the Supreme Council website for their new Faith in Action programs.

Admission Degrees: Our State Deputy has a goal of 36 admission degrees per month and 1410 new members for the year. To reach that goal, councils and districts should schedule admission degrees for each half of the year. Councils are to send admission degree schedules to District Deputies. District Deputies send schedules to Diocesan Administrators. Diocesan Administrators send schedules to State Webmaster.

Formation and Knighthood Degrees and Patriotic Degrees: Schedules for Formation and Knighthood Degrees and Patriotic Degrees will be posted to the state website. Their announcements will also be posted, so it is very important that these announcements also be sent to the State Webmaster. Also make sure that you send the original document and not a scanned version of a printed document as the quality of the scanned document is greatly reduced.

Forms and Council Information: Please make sure your report of officers has been sent to Robert Boudreaux as well as the State Deputy and your District Deputy. Updating your council information on the website is dependent on this. (Submitting the report of officers to the Supreme Council through Membership Management does not get sent to anyone else.) Work is being done to simplify the submission of forms, including the Report of Officers. The State Webmaster is also serving as Assistant Forms Chairman.
