On Those Two World Cups...

From the 12th of June to 13th of July, almost the whole world and peoples' attention were grabbed by the FIFA WORLD CUP. With the national teams of thirty two nations participating in the tournament, it seemed almost like a world-summit of people from different part of the globe. That people of every race and color and language converged in Brazil wasn't the main focal point. Instead, all eyes were on the actual trophy (The WOLD CUP!!!). One might have expected that THIS ONE WORLD CUP which brought thirty two nations and millions of people together in the

Brazilian soil probably would make for a lasting World Peace, Love and Oneness in our world. But the reverse appears to be the case. With the defeats and eliminations of teams from the tournament, starting from the group-stage, round sixteen, quarter final, semi finals and finally with the German Team defeating the Argentine's to emerge the World's champion; one cannot help but notice the atmosphere of anger, disappointment, dissatisfaction and shattered dreams, as well as jubilation and celebration for those who had their dream actualized. It is what I describe as: 'SOME WEEP, WHEN OTHERS LAUGH!!!'

But there is another World Cup which does not engender such opposing and contrary emotions among the people of world. Instead when it was inaugurated some 2000yrs ago, it was intended for the good and benefit of all peoples. This is how the New Translation of the Roman Missal put it: "*Take this all of you and drink from it, for this is the chalice (Cup) of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out 'FOR YOU AND FOR MANY' for the forgiveness of sins...*". The phrase, 'for you and for many' implies far-reaching inclusion- that many people all over the world would benefit from this new covenant. The Cup of the Blood of Jesus Christ is a WORLD CUP far greater than that of the FIFA which comes up after every other 4years. This important World Cup is given to us every day from the Sacred Altar of the sacrifice, and will continue till the end of time. Most importantly, it will become Heavenly Cup too when we shall drink from it again with Christ in the Kingdom of God, for He said: "I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom (Mt 26:29.)"

The 2014 edition of FIFA World Cup has come and gone, and will not be played again till 2018 when the next edition will come up. Congratulations to the Lovers of Soccer all over the world who committed their time to watch the games. The World Cup of the Blood of Jesus Christ continues non-stop. It is available for us to watch every day in the Altars of the Churches all over the world. It is a Cup that is poured out for the forgiveness of sins. Make haste to utilize the benefits of this all-important World Cup of Jesus' Blood.
