We are getting great results for our efforts on the Access Pregnancy Center's Baby Bottle Campaign. The donations from Infant Jesus of Prague were \$1,302, that blessing was from both masses. We are currently waiting for the results from St. Martha and their three masses. Both of these churches have very few entrances to cover when handing the bottles out. There are three at infant Jesus and two at St. Martha. We are currently scheduled to talk and hand out the bottles to all the weekend masses at ST. Joseph on April 18 -19. And collect the donations on April 25 - 26. We were also given April 25 -26 to have the talk and distribute the bottles at all the St, Anthony weekend masses, with the collection of those donations on May 2 - 3. PGK George Wedge is trying to help me resolve this schedule conflict. St Joseph has four entrances and St. Anthony has five. We will need additional help with the bottles at both churches and let us pray that we can adjust the schedule to allow us one event at a time.

Gentlemen the money that we collect all goes to the Access Pregnancy Centers services for young mothers and their babies. We are aiding in not just quality of life but in life itself by helping to provide alternative services to abortion.
