Nothing but the Gospel of Christ: On the Right of Ordination

While handing the Book of the Gospel to me on my ordination day, Archbishop says; "Francis, *Receive the Gospel of Christ, whose herald you have become. Believe what you read, teach what you believe, and practice what you teach.*" The same with the guys we were ordained together. As I listen to him giving out this paternal mandate to us with such eloquence, I remembered what Christ says to the Apostles in Mt 28:20. From that day on, I decided to place that Book of the Gospel, wide open, on a table near the door in my room, in such a way that while going out or coming into the room, my eyes must behold the Gospel of Christ. This is so awesome to me!!!

We all as Christians are called to spread the Gospel of Christ. This call takes even a deeper meaning for those who have committed their entire life to follow Christ as clergy. But neither Christ nor the Church sends us out unequipped. While Christ bestowed His Holy Spirit upon us to strengthen us for the Mission ahead, the Church, in the Sacred Rite of Ordination, presented to us the Book of the Gospel as the number one tool for our ministry as deacons. We were enjoined not just to have this Book of the Gospel placed in our bookshelves. We were commanded to read it, and to believe what we read, teach what we believe and practice what we teach. I ask you to pray for us to remain faithful to this call.
