**Did you know: Archbishop James Hubert Blenk, S.M.**

**Seventh Archbishop of New Orleans**

James Hubert Blenk was born in Neustadt, Bavaria on August 6, 1856, of Protestant parents. They moved to New Orleans when he was a child and while he was still a small boy he found joy in attending St. Mary's Assumption and St. Alphonsus Churches. After the death of Archbishop Chapelle he was notified of his elevation to the Archdiocese of New Orleans and he returned to the city on July 1, 1906. Archbishop Blenk died of a heart attack on April 20, 1917. His funeral cortege was three miles long and more than 30,000 people marched from St. Joseph's Church, New Orleans, where his body had lain in state (because the Cathedral was closed for repairs). His remains were interred in the vault under the sanctuary in St. Joseph Church.
