### November 14th Monthly Meeting

At our meeting on November 14th our council welcomed Louis Prejean and David Dawson from Catholic Community Radio. David spoke on behalf of Catholic Community Radio on their successes to date and challenges that lay ahead. Catholic Community Radio is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization which means they receive no assistance from the Archdiocese of New Orleans and depend only on the support of those who donate in various ways to the station. Currently the station broadcast at 2500 watts but plans are in place to increase the wattage to 9600. But in order to do so new broadcast towers must be built which are very expensive to do. David explained that it cost \$1500.00 per foot to build a radio broadcast tower. David and Louis are visiting Knights of Columbus Councils in the area to solicit support for the building of the new towers and asked for our support which is under consideration. The mission of Catholic Community Radio, as David explained, is part of the mission of Christ and His Church to evangelize and share the Good News of salvation in a spirit of truth and love. Thanks to Louis and David for attending our meeting and to our Lecturer Marcel Farnet III for inviting them to attend.

### Peter Compagno Sr. Memorial Champagne Brunch

On November 24th, 2013 the Champagne Brunch was held at our hall. Our Kitchen Krewe prepared a wonderful brunch and the champagne was flowing. Brunch was served from 9:00 to 2:00 and over 200 guests were served. Thanks to all that gave of their time to make this a successful event.

### Peter Joseph Compagno Sr.

Peter Joseph Compagno was born on May 14th, 1917. He went to Alcee Fortier High School. He then finished his undergraduate studies at Loyola University and then went on to get his degree in law from Loyola Law School.

One week after graduation from Law School he entered the Marine Corps as a Lieutenant and served during World War II. After the war he returned to New Orleans and began his legal career. He married Maria Taormina in November of 1947 and together they raise five children.

He had a very successful law practice as well as a burning desire to assist those less fortunate than himself. He founded and spearheaded the charitable project to aid the homeless at the Ozanam Inn through the St. Vincent DePaul Society of which he was the past president. Peter Compagno passed away on August 25, 1998. The Knights of Columbus honor our late Brother Knight, Peter Compagno Sr, for his kind and caring efforts toward those less fortunate by holding this brunch for the benefit of Ozanam Inn.
