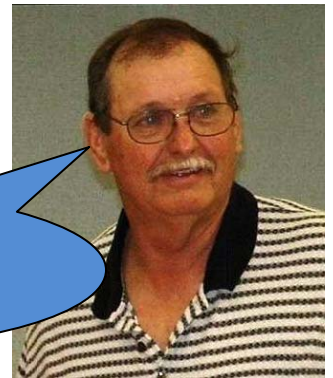


Highlights from the January 18, 2012 Council Meeting

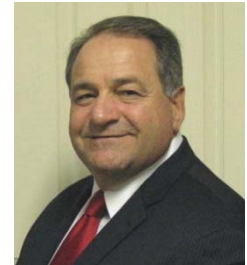

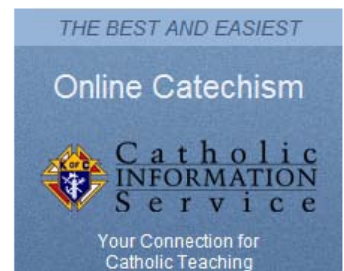
