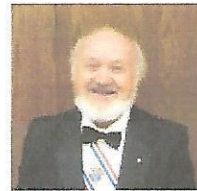

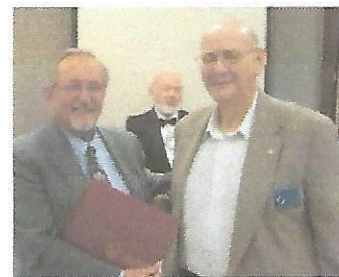


A PRAYER For Those Growing Old
