

## 2022-2023 Louisiana State Deputy's Award

Councils that satisfy the criteria set by the State Council will be eligible for the Louisiana State Deputy's Award.

#### 1. Criteria and Deadlines.

**Reporting Period:** July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023.

#### Administrative Criteria and Other Deadlines.

Refer to the deadlines, criteria, and guidance stated herein.

### 2. Method to determine 2022-2023 State Deputy's Award recipients.

A council that earns 1,600 out of the 2,000 possible points and meets the mandatory requirements qualifies for the Louisiana State Deputy Award. Every council in Louisiana can earn the Louisiana State Deputy's Award

#### 3. Objective.

The objectives of the award criteria are to:

- (1) Focus on the activities that are important to the Louisiana State Council and Louisiana Knights; and
- (2) Focus on the requirements needed to earn Star Council.

Mandatory  Must Recruit and Add  1 New Member	June 30	0	A council is <u>not</u> eligible for the Award unless it recruits and adds 1 new member. To be eligible to earn the award, the council should not appear on Supreme's list of councils which have not recorded any membership additions. Points will be based on Supreme's official report as of June 30.
Membership Quota	June 30	100+	Points = % of quota (net) as of April 5.  Example: Quota: 10. Gain: 16. Lost: 1. Net: 15. % of quota is 150% (15 out of 10) 150% = 150 points  Points will be based on Supreme's official report as of June 30.
Fraternal Benefits Seminars		100	The council must conduct two Fraternal Benefits Seminars (FBS). Each Council must have a minimum of 7 members and/or member-eligible individuals at each FBS.  To obtain credit, council must schedule/host, or promote a FBN, complete Form 11077 (Fraternal Benefit Seminar Form), and submit Form 11077 to its General Agent. The General Agent must then submit the Form 11077 to Supreme for approval, and Supreme must give the council credit.  50 points per FBS credit. 100 points max.  Points will be based on Supreme's official report as of June 30
Form 185 (Officers)	June 30	100	The council must submit this form to Supreme, and the form must be received and recorded by Supreme.  Points will be based on Supreme's official report as of September 1. The State Deputy has instructed the District Deputy to not install the councils' officers until the council has provided the District Deputy with a completed Form 185.
