I hope this communication finds you doing well. The purpose of this message is to update you on the status of our disaster preparations and relief efforts regarding Hurricane Barry.

Since last Thursday, the State leadership, Diocesan Administrators and other key personnel from around the state have been conducting video/phone conferences to discuss current conditions and to make preparations. Some of these conferences have also included representatives from Supreme Council.

More importantly, Supreme Council has generously delivered a truckload of pallets of food and supplies to be distributed to brother knights and their families who are in need of assistance. The supplies have already been pre-staged and unloaded by local brother knights, and the supplies are ready for distribution once the threat passes. Items not distributed to knights will then be made available to Church Parishes and the community based on need. More details will be announced once the threat has passed and the damage can be assessed.
