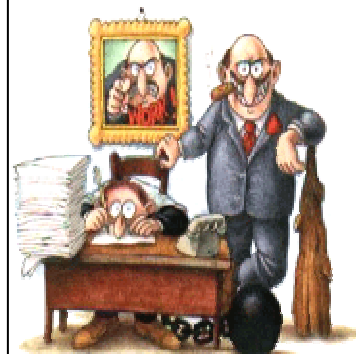

- 7) Entry will be judge on **Taste Only**.
- 8) Prizes awarded at state level in both categories: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- 9) Put your name and the year (2010) on the back of the copy of recipe that you **must submit with entry**.
- 10) Entry must be at church by 6:30 pm. (classroom)
