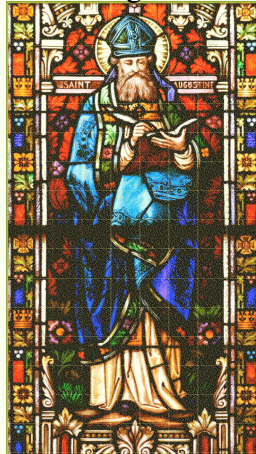
12 Catholic Virtues
