### JANUARY – Perfection

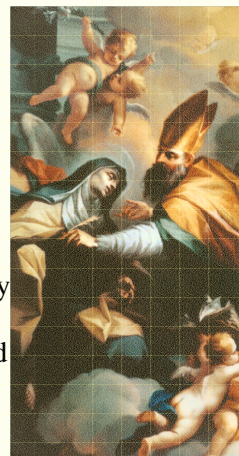
*Be ye perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect. --- Matt. 5:48*

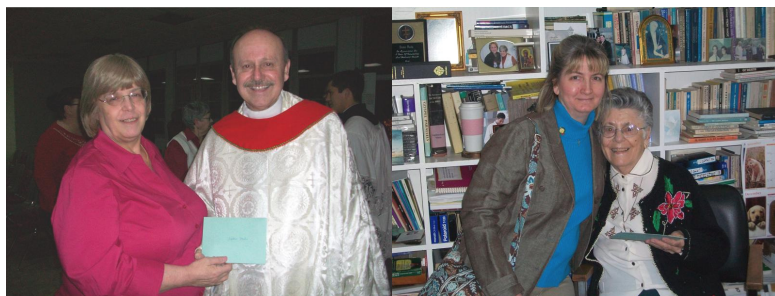
