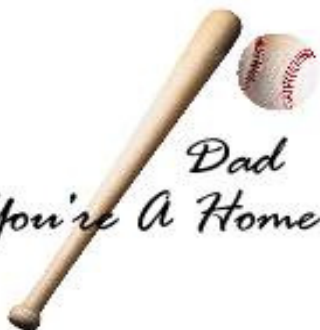

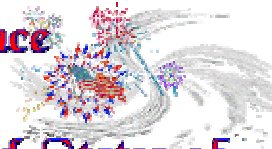
Annunziata Council 10612 recently made a \$500.00 donation to Cody Chatagnier to help with his expenses as a Seminarian.
