





Women of The Bible

Mary of Nazareth

Mary, commonly referred to as "Saint Mary", "Mother Mary", the "Virgin Mary", the "Blessed Virgin Mary", or "Mary, Mother of Jesus", was a Jewish woman of Nazareth in Galilee. She is identified in the New Testament and in Islam as the mother of Jesus through divine intervention. The Immaculate Conception of Mary is, according to Roman Catholic doctrine, the conception of the Virgin Mary without any *stain* of Original Sin. It is one of the four dogmata in Roman Catholic Mariology. Under this aspect Mary is sometimes called *Immaculata* (the Immaculate One), particularly in artistic contexts.

The New Testament begins its account of Mary's life with the Annunciation, when the angel Gabriel appeared to her and announced her divine selection to be mother of Jesus. Church tradition and early non-biblical writings state that her parents were an elderly

couple, Saint Joachim and Saint Anne. The Bible records Mary's role in key events of the life of Jesus from his conception to his Ascension. Apocryphal writings tell of her subsequent death and bodily assumption into heaven.

Update your beneficiaries

Sometimes it is easy to overlook the simplest of things.

Take the beneficiaries on your life insurance policies. If your policy was applied for and issued several years ago, it could very well be that the person you originally selected as the beneficiary is no longer the person you would want to receive the policy proceeds. If you bought the policy when you were single, for example, you may have named your parents as beneficiaries. If you have since married that should be updated to reflect your spouse or your children as beneficiaries.

Most people list a primary beneficiary, who is specifically designated as the first in priority to receive policy proceeds. We also encourage the naming of a contingent beneficiary, an alternate person designated to receive policy proceeds, usually in the event that the original beneficiary pre-deceases the insured.

Agents routinely call all policyholders for annual review appointments, usually near the anniversary date of your policy – the date it was originally issued. One of the matters that discussed during this review is the status of your beneficiary designations. If they need updating, and they often do, the agent can complete the paperwork during that appointment.
